A Snapshot of Malang

Malang is a city located within a mountainous terrain region on East Java Province, Indonesia. Malang is also the second largest city in the province.

Located in the coordinates of $7,96^{\circ}$ South Latitude and $112,61^{\circ}$ East Longitude, Malang are comfortably nestled at the hills of Mt. Kawi, endowed with beautiful mountainous sceneries, and overlaid with mild climate. The city's temperature ranges from 18°C to 28°C , which varies between rainy and dry seasons. Malang and its surrounding regions are popularly known as one of the best tourist destinations around the region.

Malang has excellent transport infrastructures, such as train stations, intercity bus, and flights to other

Education

A Brighter Future For The Graduates – Our Commitment

Up to January 2022, UB has a total of 174 licensed Study Programmes which composed from 5 Diploma Study Programmes, 77 Undergraduate Study Programmes, 69 Master's Study Programmes (including Specialist and Profession Programmes), and 23 Doctoral Study Programmes.

During the period 2014 to 2020, UB graduates output increase steadily. This steady increase, combined with an increase in the graduates' GPA level, enables UB to produce the best quality workforce for our country. To achieve ASEAN level competitiveness, to prepare for the ASEAN Economic Community (AEC), and to achieve our internal strategic goals and milestones, UB keep on striving to produce graduates who are independent, disciplined, competitive, and able to compete globally in the world.

UB has also taken steps to provide standardized certification skills and entrepreneurship skills for UB students and graduates, such as:

1. Information Technology Competency Certification. As one of the best state universities in Indonesia, UB is determined to set IT competence as

one of the graduation standards. Since August 2015, UB Rector requires standard Microsoft Office (Word, Excel, and Power Point) competency for all students of UB.

2. UB students must have TOEFL ITP (Test of English as a Foreign Language Institutional Testing Program) certification as proof of English language proficiency. TOEFL ITP is a paper-based test which evaluates the English proficiency of an individual.
3. UB supports the students and alumni with Career Development and Entrepreneurship Unit (UPKK), which aims to be the center for work information, work training, and personal development for them to prepare and enter the working world, or to be a liaison between the university with government institutions, business, and industry.

UB continues to strive to have graduates with entrepreneurial skills, one of which through the organization of the Student Entrepreneurial Program (PMW). The results of this development program are that students are initiated to develop the market. UB also continues to facilitate and develop entrepreneurship programs involving student.



Student Activities

In addition to the academic program, non-academic programs related to science, art, culture, sports, and business are also available for UB students. These programs equip the students with skills and knowledge in accordance with their wishes. Each program is overseen by competent educational personnel, while their daily programs of activities are implemented on their own.

To learn more on democratic system, students are given the opportunity to join a student organization which essentially deals with the Executive and the Legislative Affairs. Members of the legislature are elected by all UB students and the same principle applies to the President of the Student Executive Body. The Executive Body has its' own mandate to operate their strategic plans set out by the legislature and synchronize the students' needs with the University policy.

In addition, UB also has 44 student activity units, divided into 5 categories and interests, namely: reasoning, sports, the arts, student welfare, and special interests.

Students with same interest on specific topic can be formed in a group on a voluntary basis and will be overseen by educational personnel.

The group can later participate in various competitions on campus, and the winner may represent the university in both national as well as in international competitions.

Two international student organizations, namely the International Association of Agriculture students (IAAS) and the International Association of students of Economics (AIESEC) have actively maintained their international relations and conducted international conferences, student exchanges, cultural and exhibition week.

The result of the student activities is the large number of successful accomplishments achieved, such as the 2017 champion at the National Student Scientific Public Week (PIMNAS) XXX. This is the sixth time UB becomes the champion of PIMNAS, after the year 2008, 2009, 2012, 2015, 2016 and 2017.

In addition, UB students also excel incredibly in international entrepreneurship competition, by achieving hat-trick as Winner in SOI Asia Business and Gestation Plan Contest in 2012/2013, 2013/2014 and 2014/2015, beating several other teams from other universities in Asia.





Faculty Of Law

The Faculty of Law, initially named the College of Law and Society Knowledge, was established on July 1st, 1957.

Faculty of Administrative Science

Established on September 15th, 1960, Faculty of Administrative Science (hence called as FAS) has gained various achievements and both national as well as international recognitions, one of which is from Times Higher Education (THE) World University Ranking. Continuous development in learning, research, and community service capacities, followed by scientific publication and partnership with national and overseas institutions have contributed to UB's ranked 601+ in the world in the field of Business and Economics as well as Social Sciences.

With 167 qualified lectures—12 of them are full professors—FAS does not only provide regular classes but also international classes at all levels: *Sarjana's*, Master's and Doctoral degrees. All the lecturers are assigned in three departments which coordinate 11 programs.

Faculty of Agriculture

Faculty of Agriculture (FA) was established on 10 November 1960 and later becomes a state faculty by PTIP Decree No. 92 dated August 1, 1962, which effectively valid from July 1, 1962, under the auspices of the Universitas Airlangga Surabaya. When UB became a state university on January 5, 1963, the management of the Faculty of Agriculture was returned to UB.

Faculty of Mathematics and Natural Sciences (FMNS) was established in 1993 to bring forth generation of scientists through education and to contribute to the development of science through research. The Faculty of Mathematics and Natural Sciences has seventeen Study Programmes that have received national and international recognition:

Faculty of Mathematics and Natural Sciences has 154 lecturers; among them 27 are holding professor titles. Compared to the other faculties in UB, FMIPA leads in the number of lecturers with doctoral degrees (108 lecturers). Their dedication in developing science is shown by the ratio of

publication of scientific papers per lecturer that reached 3:2 in 2021, which is the highest in UB. A number of scientific works that have been further developed into innovative products include Biosains Rapid Test GAD65: a diabetes early detection kit; UB-03 Biomass Stove: a smokeless biomass-fueled stove with high combustion efficiency; and UBreath: a COVID-19 rapid detection tool with the ability to classify OTG, mild, moderate, severe, and critical symptoms. Faculty of Dentistry

The Faculty of Dentistry Universitas Brawijaya (UB) was established as the Dental Education Study Program in 2008 through the Decree of the Director-General of DIKTI Number 2123/D/T/ 2008 dated 11 July 2008, under the Faculty of Medicine UB. The change of status to Faculty was done in 2016, based on the Regulation of the Minister of Research, Technology and Higher Education of the Republic of Indonesia Number 4 of 2016 on 22 January 2016, concerning the Organization of Universitas Brawijaya.

Faculty of Dentistry has 2 Study Programmes, namely the Bachelor of Dentistry Study Program (A LAMPTKes accreditation), which produces Graduates of Bachelor of Dentistry (BDS), and the Dental Profession Study Program (B LAMPTKes accreditation), which produces Dental graduates (DDS).

The Faculty of Dentistry has 50 teaching staff and 33 supporting staff to perform academic activities. Based on their expertise, the teaching staff at the Faculty of Dentistry UB are divided into 12 areas of expertise, namely Pediatric Dentistry, Periodontics, Oral Diseases, Dental Conservation, Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery, Prosthodontics,

Orthodontics, Oral Biology, Dental Materials Science, Dental Radiology, Community-Preventive Dentistry Science, and Dental Nanotechnology.

In an effort to support the academic atmosphere, the Faculty of Dentistry UB provides various educational, research, and student facilities. Facilities at the Faculty of Dentistry include lecture rooms, discussion rooms, reading room, Computer Based Test (CBT) room, OSCE CENTER room, an oral biology laboratory, dental preclinical skills laboratory, and dentistry clinical skills laboratory. Facilities at the Faculty of Dentistry UB are equipped with





representative equipment, namely: LCD projector, desktop/ laptop computer, air conditioning, chairs and tables, and information technology facilities with internet networks or Wi-Fi access for 24 hours throughout the FKG area.

Faculty of Dentistry UB collaborates with various national and international institutions in order to support the achievement of high-quality education. National cooperation between the Faculty of Dentistry UB includes the Kediri Regency General Hospital and the Dr. Iskak Tulungagung General Hospital as a Network Teaching Hospital. The Faculty of Health Sciences (FIKes) officially becomes a faculty in UB on December 28, 2021. The Faculty of Health Sciences is the 17th Faculty that was established at Universitas Brawijaya. is a transformation of the Department of Nursing and the Department of Nutrition which previously joined under the auspices of the Faculty of Medicine since 1997.

Currently, FIKes has two departments namely Nursing and Nutrition with five Study Programmes:

4. Dietitian Professional Study Programme

Graduate School of Brawijaya University (SPUB)

The Graduate School of Universitas Brawijaya was initiated in 1981. It started with a collaboration with Gadjah Mada University as a Credit Collection Activity Program (*Kegiatan Pengumpulan Kredit*) Gadjah Mada University - Brawijaya University. International Office UB (IOUB)

IOUB is the main bridge that connects Universitas Brawijaya with foreign partners or parties. IOUB's vision is ameliorate the administration development and implementation of programs to improve the reputation of Universitas Brawijaya in the international education field.

IOUB's missions is:

1. Coordinating the attainment for foreign student admissions and scholarships provision, including the promotion of UB abroad.
2. Coordinating the enactment of foreign lecturers and students exchange program activities.
3. Contrivance of the administrative services to foreign lecturers and students.
4. Coordinating the preparation, recording, and evaluation of international cooperation in Tri Dharma PT.
5. Monitoring, evaluation, and analysis services for foreign lecturers and students, also compiling monitoring and evaluation periodic reports.

6. Upgrade academic community participation to support the international program in UB.

The services at IOUB:

1. *International Students Admission* which processes the admission of new foreign student; promotion of study abroad programs; and manage foreign student database.
2. *International Student and Staff Mobility* which conducts promotion for mobility programs to students and staff; process student participation in mobility activities (outbound and inbound - short term non-degree programs); and manage mobility database (non-degree).
3. *International Collaboration* which processes foreign cooperation proposals (from outside or within UB); process foreign lecturer contracts; and manage international cooperation database.
4. *Academics and Student Advisory* which supervise study progress of UB's foreign student, assist and provide counseling for foreign student; increase cross cultural understanding between foreign students and domestic students at UB.

Routine activities held by IOUB:

1. *International Student Service Evaluation* (ISSE) to determine the assessment of foreign students on the types of services available at the International Office.
2. *Socialization of Licensing of Foreign Citizens* which provides an understanding of all regulations regarding licensing that must be owned by foreign students studying at Universitas Brawijaya.
3. *Cultural of Indonesia Understanding for International Students* (CIUS) which provides opportunities for foreign students to get to know and learn about Indonesian culture.

Procedure for Admission of Foreign Students**Eligibility for Admission:**

1. Candidates will be regarded as international applicants if they are not of Indonesian nationality.
2. Candidates must demonstrate good academic competence proven by high academic merit. International applicants should apply directly to UB by filling the online application form and submitting a set of necessary documents.
3. The eligibility for admission is based on a desk evaluation conducted by the UB admissions committee on the academic achievement of candidates. There is no entry test for admissions unless special conditions are present.
4. International applicants must meet academic and language requirements and commit to comply with specific regulations of the Indonesian government related to education policy in order to apply for a degree at UB.
5. International Undergraduate Program applicants should demonstrate English language proficiency with a minimum International TOEFL (ITP) score of 500/IELTS overall score of 5.5 (international programs in English) or a

minimum of Indonesian language proficiency (regular programs in Indonesian).

Documents that should be prepared to apply online:

1. Current color photograph (min: 100 Kb, max: 1 Mb)
2. Certificate/diploma and academic transcript
3. Evidence of English proficiency certificate – TOEFL/IELTS (for non-native speakers of English)
4. Certificate of Indonesian language course(s) (if any)
5. Copy of passport
6. For Master's and PhD programs, a research proposal is required to be submitted via e-mail to io@ub.ac.id

Based on UB Rector Regulation No. 93 of 2021 concerning Organizational Structure under the Chancellor, BIIW (Body for Innovation and Entrepreneurial Incubator) changed its name to the Directorate of Innovation and Business Incubator Universitas Brawijaya (DI2B) under the auspices of the Vice Chancellor for Research and Innovation

DI2B UB plays a role in accommodating, assisting, and producing creative and innovative entrepreneurs, especially from students, lecturers, and education staff in Universitas Brawijaya, and is also open to elements of society outside Universitas Brawijaya.

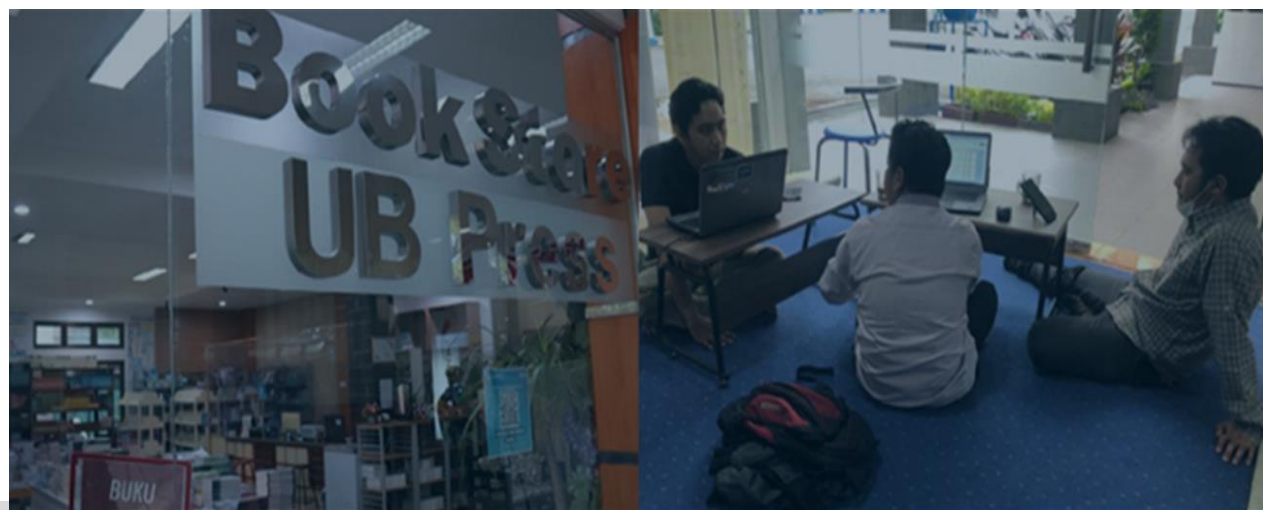

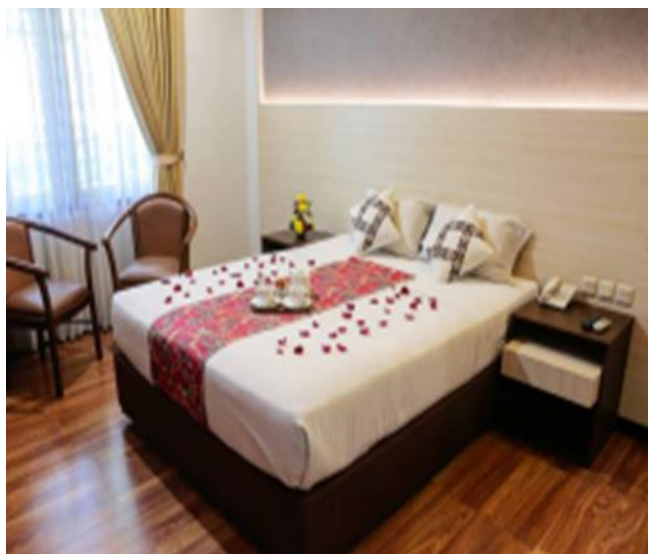

Quality Assurance Centre

In order to continuous quality improvement, relevance, and efficiency of Universitas Brawijaya's services in the global era, the management of UB requires an Internal Quality Assurance System (IQAS). The Quality Assurance Centre of Universitas Brawijaya (QAC-UB) was determined by the Rector as a functional institution with the mandate to develop IQAS in UB.

Quality Assurance Centre Universitas Brawijaya (QAC-UB) has a vision to develop IQAS in UB to become a world class entrepreneurial university. The vision of QAC-UB is realized by setting the mission: developing and implementing IQAS in UB; actively participate in the development of an early warning system; and become to the center of excellence in IQAS.

Quality Assurance Centre Universitas Brawijaya (QAC-UB), has the duties of IQAS and monitors its implementation, so that it can support the fulfillment of the needs of the External Quality Assurance System (EQAS), i.e., accreditation. QAC-UB consists of 3 deputies and 6 centers which represent their duties and functions. The deputies and centers are:

1. Deputy of Organizational Accreditation:

- a. Internal Quality Assurance System Centre
- b. Quality Internal Audit Centre

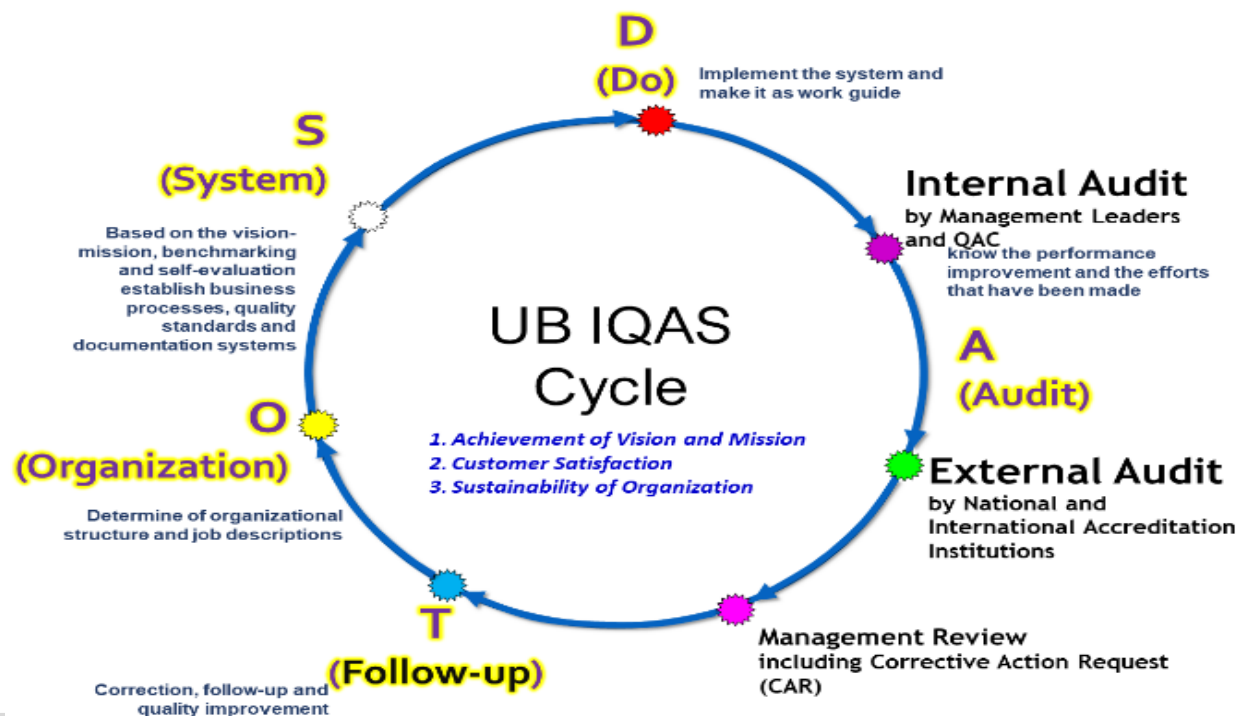
2. Deputy of Education Accreditation:

- a. National Accreditation Centre
- b. International Accreditation/Certification Centre

3. Deputy of Ratings:

- a. National Reputation Centre
- b. International Reputation Centre

The implementation of IQAS UB in order to fulfill EQAS (National Accreditation of Higher Education, Indonesian Accreditation Agency for Higher Education in Health, and International Accreditation) encourages QAC-UB to develop a unique IQAS, which combines Higher Education Quality Assurance System in Higher Education, ISO 9001 QMS, BAN-PT /LAM Accreditation System, Excellent Service Standards, AUN-QA Certification Criteria, and several other international accreditation requirements.



The implementation of IQAS (since 2007) has a good impact on the implementation of the quality management system in supporting units, in addition to develop quality, improving academic peer review and academic atmosphere, as well as minimizing incompliance with regulations and avoiding non-conformity performance. This is evidenced by the increase in the number of accredited Study Programmes with "A" and "Excellent" ratings in UB.

The improvement in quality and reputation i.e.:

1. UB was selected as the 8th best university in Indonesia by the Ministry of Research, Technology and Higher Education in 2017.
2. UB gets appreciation as one of five Higher Education Caregivers who implement the PT Asuh Programme Towards Excellent Study Programmes in 2017, 2018 and 2019 seriously by the Directorate General of Learning and Student Affairs of the Ministry of Research, Technology and Higher Education.
3. Accreditation of Institution in Higher Education "A" rating from National Accreditation of Higher Education (BAN-PT) since 2009 and updated in 2014 and 2018. In 2022, UB is able to convert accreditation to "Excellent" rank.

4. Of the 174 Study Programmes in UB, 35% of them have been accredited with an Excellent rank, 30% Study Programmes have been accredited A, and 30% Study Programmes have been accredited B.
5. ISO 9001:2008 certification for all UB since 2011, ISO 17025:2005 for Central Laboratory of Living Sciences (LSIH) since 2012 and Central Laboratory of Science and Engineering (LSSR) since 2019.
6. UB is selected as the best SPMPT Implementer in 2008 by the Directorate of Higher Education of Indonesia.
7. Since 2012, 25% Study Programmes at UB have obtained international accreditation/certification.

Institute of Research and Community Services of Universitas Brawijaya

Institute of Research and Community Services (IRCS UB) was established in 2008 as the incorporation of the Research Institution (LEMLIT) and the institution of Community Services (LPM) that existed and initiated since 1978. In 2021, following the transformation of Universitas Brawijaya into a Legal Entity State University, IRCS UB performs as the institution to organize and manage research & community services under the coordination of Vice Rector of Research and Innovation.

IRCS UB organizes the core and flagship programs as follows:

- Research; includes research grants from the central government, international and internal funding such as Junior Research Grant/ HPP, Flagship Research Grant/ HPU, Flagship Development Research Grant/ HAPPU, International Collaboration Research/ HAPKI, Centre of Study Empowerment, and Strategic Research Grant)
- Community Services; includes community services from the central government and internal funding such as *Doktor Mengabdi*

Grant, *Doktor Mengabdi* in Frontier Areas, and Strategic Community Services Grant

- Cooperation with Ministries, Institutions, Local Governments, Private Companies (Business and Industry), Communities, etc

- Prepare the leadership qualities through entrepreneurs and collaboration of society's potency.

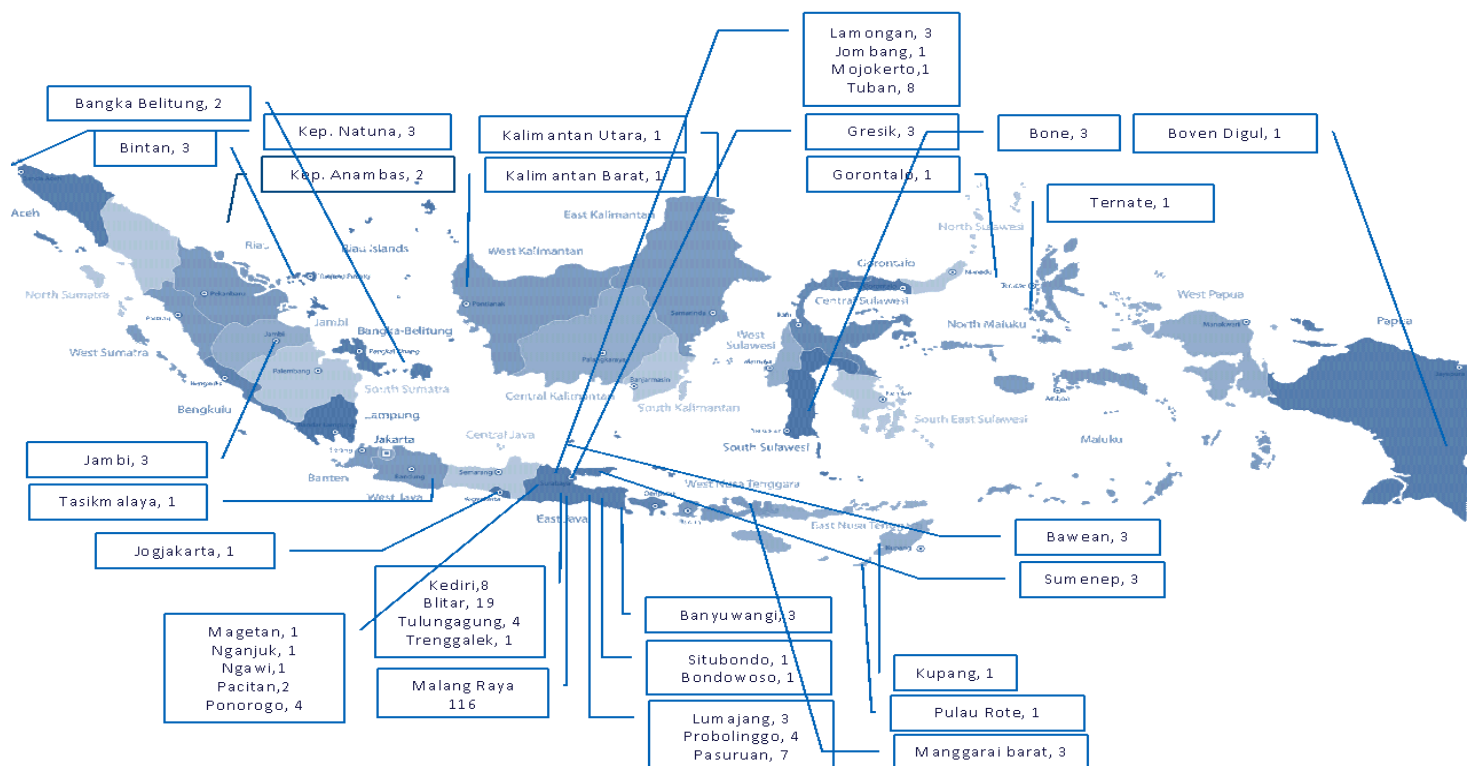

Central Laboratory of Life Sciences (LSIH) Universitas Brawijaya

LSIH is a central laboratory under Universitas Brawijaya, a technical Implementation unit that provides testing, research, and community services based on ISO 9001:2015 and ISO/IEC 17025:2017 standards. The vision of LSIH Universitas Brawijaya is to become an institution that provides research facilities and testing services to support the development of science and technology (IPTEK).

Meanwhile, the mission of LSIH Universitas Brawijaya is:

1. Planning and providing adequate research facilities for students and researchers both from Universitas Brawijaya and non-Universitas Brawijaya in accordance with the quality standards of Universitas Brawijaya.
2. Improving the ability and quality of researchers (Human resources) who are professional and have personality.
3. Provide services for research and development of life sciences, medicine, public health, basic sciences, and related fields of study in accordance with the quality standards of Universitas Brawijaya and/or ISO/IEC 17025:2017.

The objectives of LSIH Universitas Brawijaya are:

1. Providing quality research facilities in accordance with the quality system of Universitas Brawijaya which is an international standard.

2. Organizing training and tutorials for students and researchers in the field of research and the development of new knowledge.
3. Organizing research analysis services in accordance with quality manual standards and/or ISO/IEC 17025:2017.
4. Organizing assistance and network of international standard analytical service systems according to ISO/IEC 17025:2017 in Universitas Brawijaya.



The achievement of LSIH Universitas Brawijaya has 12 test scopes. This scope has been certified ISO/IEC 17025:2017 by the National Accreditation Committee (KAN). The scope of the test includes Moisture Content, Ash Content, Fat Content, Total Plate Count Test and *Escherichia coli* Test on wheat flour commodities, Moisture Content, Ash Content, Fat Content, Total Plate Count Test, and *Escherichia coli* Test on biscuit commodities, Detection of Pig DNA using PCR on Meatballs and Sausage Commodities. This year, it is planned to expand to 30 certified scopes.

As a form of community service, LSIH has collaborated with several related agencies. which has been evidenced by the signing of a cooperation agreement, in the fields of:

1. Cooperation in the field of training. LSIH has collaborated with the following institutions: Indonesian Institute of Sciences (LIPI), Center for Plant Seedling and Plant Protection (BBPPTP) Surabaya, Saiful Anwar Hospital Malang, Eijkman Institute, PT Shimadzu Asia Pacific, Lambung Mangkurat University, Papua State University, Khairun University, Ternate, UPN Veterans Integrated Testing Laboratory, Mulawarman University, and Sunan Gunung Djati State Islamic University, Bandung.

2. Cooperation in the field of testing. To fulfill one of the requirements for establishing a Halal Inspection Agency (LPH) is to own or cooperate with a certified laboratory. As a form of service to the community in terms of testing, LSIH has signed a cooperation agreement with LPH in several regions of Eastern Indonesia, including: LPH Brawijaya University, LPH Bahrul Maghfiroh Malang, LPH Nurul Munawwiry Probolinggo, LPH Trunojoyo Madura, LPH 1455 Pondok Pesantren Sidogiri Pasuruan, LPH UIN Maulana Malik Ibrahim Malang, Halal Examination Board of PWNU East Java, LPH Blitar University.

3. Cooperation in the field of research. LSIH has also collaborated with the following universities: Kassel Universitat, Kentucky University, Toxem University, Le Mans Universite, University of Szczecin, Universite Du Maine, Universidad De Las Palmas De Gran Canaria, and the University of Copenhagen.

With the increasingly sophisticated equipment supporting research and the support of LSIH services with competent and certified human resources, LSIH has served users from internal Brawijaya University and institutions outside Brawijaya University with positive feedback.

External users of LSIH from educational institutions are as follows: State University of Malang, Muhammadiyah University of Malang, State Islamic University of Maulana Malik Ibrahim Malang, Islamic University of Malang, Health Polytechnic of Malang, State University of Surabaya, Airlangga University Surabaya, Wijaya Kusuma University Surabaya, Institute Technology of

Institute of Educational Development or Lembaga Pengembangan Pendidikan (LPP)

Education is the main business of Brawijaya University (UB), which is one of the obligations of implementing Tri Dharma. Implementing quality education is the UB's function and objective as a higher education institution. Therefore, efforts to provide high-quality education are the main academic activities at Brawijaya University. In 1998, Brawijaya University established the Institute for Educational Research and Development (LP3) to improve education quality continuously. It evolved into the Institute for Educational Development and Quality Assurance (LP3M) in 2016. It became an Institute for Educational Development Institute (LPP) in 2021 when Universitas Brawijaya changed its form to a Legal Entity University (PTNBH UB).

The existence of LPP is crucial for the sustainability of Universitas Brawijaya because, until now, education has been the main business activity of PTNBH UB. The quality of education needs to be continuously improved, especially in times of change that are increasingly dominated by digital technology.

Learning methods, education management, and the quality of human resources in providing education continue to be developed along with the developments of various fields of science, technology, and art that are dynamically growing.

LPP takes a role in maintaining the quality of education through various activities carried out with the support of 4 centers owned, namely:

- Learning Activity and Technology Development Center (P2ATP)
- Education Relevance Development Center (P2RP)
- Center for Professional Academic Education Development (P3AP)
- Education Management Development Center (P2MP)

In accordance with the Chancellor's Regulation no. 93 of 2021, LPP has the following duties:

- Formulate and implement policies in the field of education development
- Organizing work programs that are in line with education development policies

- Evaluating and reporting on performance achievements in the field of education development and
- Organizing excellent academic development services in accordance with good university governance.

In carrying out its duties, LPP has the following functions:

- Planning and implementation of education development policies
- Development of learning and education
- Monitoring and evaluation of learning and education development and
- Implementation of excellent academic development services in accordance with good university governance

In carrying out its duties and functions, LPP actively processes upskilling lecturers through training activities that include Basic Instructional Skills Training (PEKERTI), Applied Approach (AA) Program, and training in learning methods and technology. Study activities in the management development aspect of education administration by considering technological and regulatory developments, improving education management capabilities, studies to formulate policies in the implementation of learning, evaluation of study program development, curriculum development, and other aspects for

the development of education administration. LPP carries out dissemination activities in the education aspect through the publication of the Eurodio journal. Various LPP activities can be seen on the LPP official website.

Assigned lecturers and education staff carry out LPP management. Developing the competence of lecturers and education staff assigned to LPP is done through skill and knowledge improvement. Cooperation with various parties is carried out by LPP, both with national and international institutions. Comparative study activities from outside parties to LPP and from LPP out are carried out as a form of knowledge development. Technical and management training is conducted for skills development.

Central Laboratory of Science and Engineering Brawijaya University (LSSR)

History Central Laboratory of Science and Engineering of Universitas Brawijaya

At the beginning of its establishment, the Central Laboratory of Science and Engineering Universitas Brawijaya was an institution assigned to guarantee the trustworthiness and traceability of all data and information produced by all laboratories in Universitas Brawijaya. In 2016, LSSR has officially entered into the UB Governance Organization and is a Technical Implementation Unit directly under the coordination of the Chancellor. In early 2016, LSSR occupied a room on the 2nd floor of the Rectorate Building with the ability to calibrate 5 basic quantities, namely: electricity, mass, volume, pressure, and temperature.

The rapid development, especially in the world of education, then encouraged LSSR to start the internal calibration process at Brawijaya University even though the ISO 17025 Accreditation process was still in the preparation stage for sending files. This activity is also to carry out the preparation stage and carry out self-calibration exercises before the actual calibration activities are ready to be carried out. The LSSR strategic plan is expected to have a strategic role to help Brawijaya University become an international entrepreneurial university (World Class Entrepreneurial University or WCEU), which was set on June 2, 2007, in the UB senate meeting.

In 2019 the Central Laboratory of Science and Engineering (LSSR) succeeded in obtaining accreditation recognition by the national accreditation body of the National Accreditation Committee (KAN) in 3 scopes of magnitude.

Since then, LSSR began to develop and add other scopes such as pH meters and volumetrics. Where volumetric accreditation will be submitted by the national accreditation body KAN this year. The following is an ISO 17025:2017 accreditation certificate from KAN to LSSR in 2019.
